You are responsible for any loss or damage to rented equipment during the term of the equipment rental agreement.

A Rental Damage Waiver provides an easy way to help protect against costly bills for major repairs or replacement of rented equipment.

The Rental Damage Waiver is not insurance. It is an agreement between you and the rental dealership that limits your financial responsibility for loss or damage to rented equipment, in exchange for a fee, subject to the terms and conditions of the rental agreement and any applicable state law.

WHY PURCHASE A RENTAL DAMAGE WAIVER?

- Helps limit your financial responsibility in the event of loss or damage to rented equipment
- Reduces any exposure to your primary insurance policies
- Eliminates the need to provide proof of physical damage insurance before renting equipment
